

Eats and Treats in Harrisonburg

There are several shops and quite a few restaurants, coffee shops and bars within walking distance of Hotel Madison and St. Stephen's UCC.

Coffee and Breakfast

Broad Porch

Probably the best local roaster. The cafe on Court Square has a pretty full breakfast menu. The shop in Agora Market is really close for a pick-me-up.

Heritage Bakery

Super yummy pastries. And they have coffee.

Magpie

Great brunchy-type place. A little further away and often quite busy.
